New Features in Options 2022

Manually Creating / Seeding a Pattern


For those Users who wish to 'Seed' or build-up a Pattern manually, there is now extra help to do this as follows: On the Design a Pattern Screen, either create a new pattern, or choose an existing one, and view it (double-click on it, or click 'View Pattern'). You will see 2 new features.



1.
If you tick on: Show Subjects

then the right-hand side table shows, for each Subject,

- how many Students have chosen that subject,
- how many Groups of that subject are on your Pattern currently, and



• the maximum number of Groups you said earlier (on the Subjects Screen) that this subject can have.

Where there is a mismatch between the last two figures, they are coloured in yellow (too many groups on your pattern), or green (too few groups) to draw your attention to it.

2. Near the bottom of that screen is a new 'Quick Assign' button: Quick Assign Quic

The Assign / View Students button has always been there, and is rigorous and checks with you whether you want to save your changes to the pattern, whether you want to apply strict group sizes, etc.

But if you are Manually designing a pattern, you may wish to check how students fit into your pattern more often and quicker. You can now do this, using the Quick Assign @ button.

This doesn't ask you any questions, but saves your pattern, uses the *same* group size rules as you chose last time, and reassigns all students to the pattern, then displays the Current Pattern screen to you, so you can see where the students have been placed, the satisfaction %, etc. When happy, close the Current Pattern screen, and you are dropped back to the Pattern to make another change, if you wish.

To change the assignment settings that are being used, click Assign / View Students and choose them — then you can go back to clicking Quick Assign ①.

1. 'View Requests' (if there are any for this student) is now bolder:




And when you click 'View Requests', you are now given the option to add or edit the requests:

2. If you hover your mouse over any group, you are now shown more information about the students in that group:

As before, you can double-click to see the students in the group. (This can be especially useful if the 'View Requests' message is displayed for this student. You can more easily see where the student s/he wishes to be with/separate from, is currently placed.)



3. The Review Rules (2) button now tells you how many (active/unsuspended) Rules there are (in brackets).



Customized Export



At Export Customized File it is now more customizable, by the addition of 2 optional filters:

- 1. Sort-order (of Students): you can reorder the Students in the report (note: it may not work for every report, as some reports may by their nature require a particular order).
- 2. Students: you can now choose to export just those students missing a choice, if you wish to analyse these particular students. Or just those who have not been 100% satisfied (ie. not all their choices are placed in your current Pattern).




'By Subject' Report

This Report, on the Current Pattern Screen → By Subject:

has been improved, so that

- it stays visible / on top of the Current Pattern Screen, while you continue to make changes to your pattern, and move students around, etc.
- any changes you make (via Shuffle, Split, Equal, Bunch, etc) are updated in the 'By Subject' report in real time.

Speed of Auto-Create

A few improvements have been made to the speed of AutoCreate, for larger schools.

Improvements to TOOLS

TOOLS now allows you to choose 'Multiple Sites': this exports a Student file for each class ... so you can easily import different students into each of your TOOLS sites.

Backup & Restore

Options has the same 'Cloud' (Dropbox, GoogleDrive, Microsoft OneDrive, Sync, etc) & USB options as in **TimeTabler**.



Current Pattern

There is a new feature to copy student assignments from a Seed (say) to another Pattern: More Transfer assignments between Patterns Save student assignments.
